Gates Camp Head Cook – Seasonal/Summer 2019

Club/Office Location: Gates Camp

Job Description:

BGCMD operates a residential summer program where under-served inner city youth, ages 8 to 13, attend 5 day/4 night low cost, and in many cases, no cost, sessions. Kids/Campers participate in hiking, canoeing, sleeping under the stars, fishing, rock climbing, archery, hands-on games, and other outdoor activities. The Gates Camp program inspires kids to explore new ideas, develop a connection with the environment, work as a community, and support one another in the achievement of their personal potential. BGCMD is currently hiring one (1) Head Cook to live and work at Gates Camp between the dates of May 16th and July 30th.

BGCMD requires the following of all Camp employees:

- Staff members must be at least 21 years of age
- Minimum of 1 year previous kitchen/foodservice experience or relevant experience
- Ability to pass pre-employment screenings including drug test which does test for marijuana, criminal background check, references and Department of Motor Vehicle records check

The Head Cook must:

- Support and adhere to daily food preparation and meal schedules and ensure timelines
- Comply with Federal, State and County regulations as they apply to food service procedures and practices
- Manage and work cooperatively with the Assistant Cook and the Dishwasher/Prep Cook to prepare and serve meals
- Effectively monitor food stores to limit spoilage and ensure quality
- Check-in and document all food/supply orders
- Prepare meals from "scratch" using healthy and fresh ingredients that ensure a balanced and nutritious diet for Campers and Staff
- Be willing to prepare meals for a variety of dietary needs and preferences (i.e. gluten free, vegetarian, vegan, dairy and/or soy free, nut allergies, etc.)
- Support the realization of a "Healthy Lifestyle" for Campers and Staff
- Ensure that food items are available for staff to prepare meals for themselves on weekends
- Post daily/weekly menus in advance of serving meals
- Create and maintain a sanitary environment for food storage, preparation and the serving of meals;
- Perform and facilitate weekly deep cleaning of specific areas in the kitchen (floors, vent hoods, walk-ins, dish cleaning area, ovens, etc.)
- Proactively manage and mitigate risk in the food service environment

Job Requirements:

Physical Requirements/ Work Environment

The successful candidate must be able to work at high altitude (at or above 9,000 ft), have stamina to work through long days and evenings, and have the ability to perform basic maintenance functions. Camp Staff may, at times, have to lift up to and over 50lbs. This position requires close collaboration with all staff including the Camp's Directors, Program Staff and Camp's Healthcare Professional.

Job Related Behaviors

Gates Camp Staff are team players and must be punctual, flexible; each team member must follow through on commitments, respond in a timely manner to requests, exhibit problem solving skills and initiative, communicate effectively and follow proper reporting procedures. The right candidate is dedicated to the Mission of the organization and strives to uphold the Boys and Girls Club of Metro Denver's Core Values.
