Be ready to become part of a team that serves up to 200 kids per day and gain valuable experience working with a variety of age groups (6-18).

In this role you will gain experience in the following:

- Creative autonomy to develop and implement fun artistic activities and programs.
- Direct experience creating lesson plans and working with small groups (5-10 kids), regular groups (20-30 kids) and large groups (40+ kids) in artistic, recreation and academic settings.
- An understanding of the five (5) elements of positive youth development: a safe positive environment, fun, supportive relationships, opportunities and expectations, and recognition.
- Experience collaborating with a team of professionals who share similar passions.
- Program and event development, community engagement, nightly dinners, routine paperwork and ongoing facility maintenance
- Collaboration with neighborhood schools, the local community as well as various organizations.
- Training in the Cultural Arts room, game room, gym and any program area as needed.
